Children should come to school in their P.E. kit on their assigned day.



As readers and writers we will be learning to ...

- Write a persuasive letter from the perspective of a character from our class text, 'Secrets of a Sun King' by Emma Carroll.
- Compose a newspaper report about a main event from our class text, ensuring we write in the correct style for the time period we would have been writing in.
- Write the next part of a narrative using direct speech.
- Use dictionaries and thesauruses to improve our word choices.

As scientists we will be learning to...

- Identifying the different functions of parts of a flower.
- Investigating factors which affect plant growth , and how water is transported through the stem .
- Learning about the processes of pollination and fertilisation.
- Discussing how plants make their own food (photosynthesis).

As creative learners we will...

- Investigate and use a range of different media available to use in the classroom, to design and create a depiction of ourselves as an Egyptian Pharaoh.
- Design and create artwork using a range of media depicting an Egyptian sarcophagus.
- Discover different shading, blending and texturing techniques.

As linguists we will be learning to ...

- Describe various parts of the human body.
- Apply new language to songs.

As mathematicians we will be learning to ...

- Add and subtract 3 and 4-digit numbers using the formal written methods.
- Use column multiplication and the bus-stop method of division.
- Multiply and divided mentally by 1, 0, 10 and 100.
- Consolidate our knowledge of our times tables, both multiplying and dividing.

As explorers we will be learning ...

- to place Ancient Egypt on a timeline and understand its location in the world in relation to modern day.
- how to make comparisons between the modern day and Ancient Egypt.
- about the Ancient Egyptian ritual of mummification and instructing someone on how to do this.
- how evidence can give us answers about the past.
- the significance of Howard Carter's discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb.
- to compare and contrast the powers of the many ancient Egyptian Gods.
- how to explain what an artefact shows about the Ancient Egyptians.
- who built the first pyramids and their importance in Egyptian life.
- to understand and decode hieroglyphics.
