We always read from *left* to *right*.

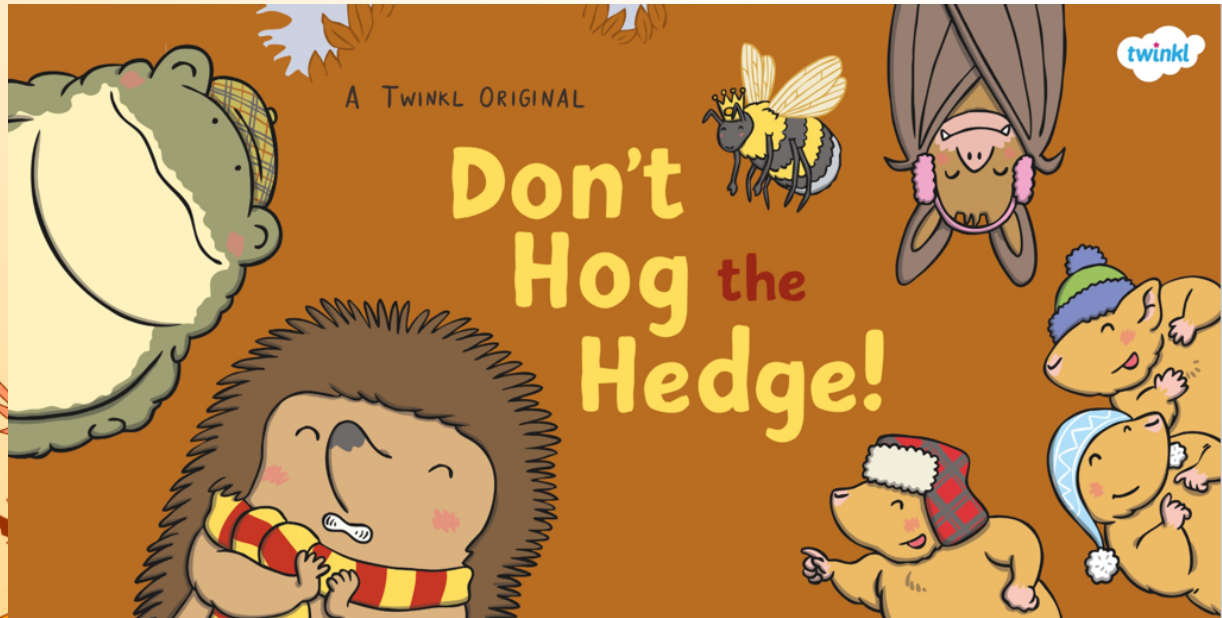

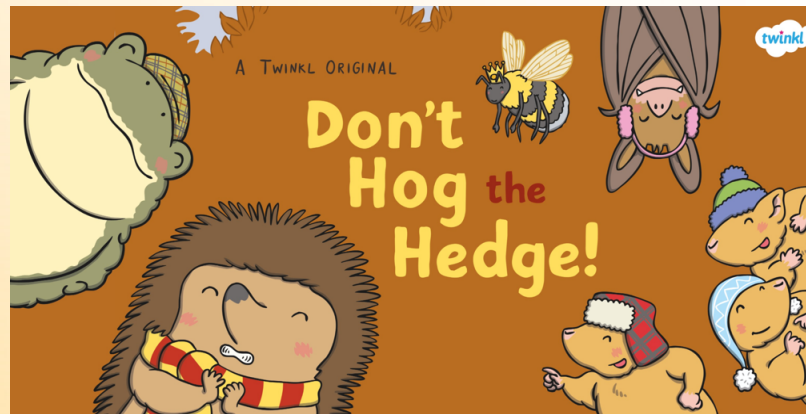

Where might a story about a dolphin take place?

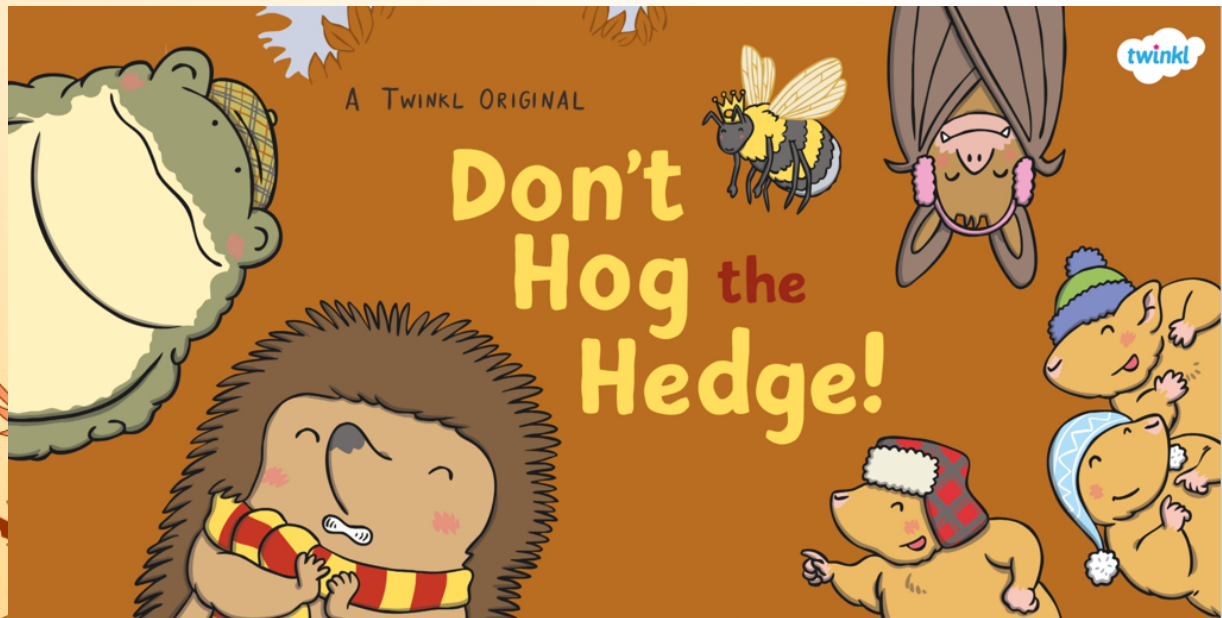
The sea is
