## PRIME AREAS

### Communication & Language

#### We are learning to...

Talk clearly and answer questions during group sessions.  
Talk with our friends and discuss what we are doing when playing.  
Recite nursery rhymes with confidence.

### Personal, Social & Emotional Development

#### We are learning to...

Share toys and resources with others.  
Listen to others and take turns.  
Play in small groups.  
Respond to our own feelings and those of others.

### Physical Development

#### We are learning to...

Develop riding skills (scooters, trikes and bikes).  
Climb up apparatus, using alternate feet.

## SPECIFIC AREAS

### Literacy

#### We are learning to...

Join in with lots of nursery rhymes. We will use these rhymes in our story time sessions to learn more about each rhyme and answer questions about them.  
Handle books with care and enjoy them in our book area.

### Maths

#### We are learning to...

Listen and join in with number rhymes like '1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive' and '5 little ducks'.  
Recognise some numbers through 1 -10 and learn more about what each number represents.

### Understanding the World

#### We are learning to...

Look closely at ourselves and discuss what makes each one of us special. We will look at the similarities and differences between us and our friends.  
We will be discovering how to use a range of resources available in school and learn how they can be fun and useful.
