During this half-term we would like the children to design their own Easter egg packaging.


### The learning objectives for this activity are:

As we begin to learn to read and write we will be learning to:

- Look at books independently.
- Practise writing our names on warrant cards, ID badges.
- Label buildings and people in relation to their occupations: Fire fighters, Doctors, Drivers, Shop-keepers, Nurses.
- Hear and say the initial sounds in words.



As explorers of our world and growing individuals we will be:

- Looking closely at similarities and differences, patterns and change.
- Listening and responding to simple instructions.
- Sharing our knowledge and understanding and asking appropriate questions of others.
- Showing an interest in the lives and occupations of family and friends.
- Learning that we have similarities and differences that connect us to, and distinguish us from, others.



As mathematicians we will be learning to ...

- Count vehicles, people, friends etc. using 1-1 correspondence.
- Use shapes to design ambulances, shops, schools, hospitals etc.
- Match numerals and quantities correctly.
- Notice simple patterns and shapes in pictures, clothing etc. and use shapes appropriately for tasks.



As friends we will be learning to ...

- Initiate play and invite our friends to join us. Accept the needs of our friends as well as expressing our own needs.
- Negotiate and solve problems without aggression.

As creative learners we will be...

- Creating simple representations of people from different occupations.
- Building a repertoire of songs and dances.
- Designing our own Easter egg packaging.
- Experimenting with colour, block and different media to create patterns and designs.
